Testers are selected based on several criteria: When form is received; the product being tested, and the member's skills and interests. Once chosen, testers are required to complete and return a report form on the product tested. The tester keeps the product free of charge. At least 67 percent of testers need to recommend a product for it to receive the Member Tested & Recommended seal.
